## Good afternoon Jaguars!

Thank you for a fabulous start to the school year! We want to ensure that all parents are aware of our JJB grading policies that connect to the CCSD Grading Reform expectations. Teachers shared this information during their Open House presentations on August 9, 2024, and will review it during Parent-Teacher Conferences on October 14, 2024. Additional information regarding Parent-Teacher Conference scheduling will be sent home in the next few weeks.

In order to ensure some consistency across JJB, these are a few expectations for 1st through 5th grade, related to CCSD Grade Reform guidelines.

- Formative Assessments will account for 10% of the final grade.
- Students do not have the opportunity to retake formative assessments, as these
  assessments provide valuable information to inform instruction and determine if students
  are prepared for a summative assessment.
- Summative assessments will account for 90% of the final grade.
- Students have the opportunity to retake summative assessments by requesting the
  retake through a request from. All summatives must be retaken no later than two weeks
  prior to the end of the term. Teachers will teach this process to students and
  communicate expectations to families.
- Late assignments can be submitted up to two weeks after the due date.

- Homework expectations are in accordance with <u>Policy 6143</u> and <u>Regulation 6143</u>.
   Homework is considered practice or an extension of learning. For this reason, the completion of homework impacts Learner Behavior grades, it does not count toward the final content area grade.
- Learner behavior grades (classroom citizenship and other nonacademic measures) are determined using the rubric.
