1. Explanation

1. What is a Past Participle?

A past participle is a verb form used in perfect tenses (like the Present Perfect) and in the passive voice. It is often the third form of a verb.

Example of verb forms:

Base Form	Past Simple	Past Participle
go	went	gone
eat	ate	eaten
buy	bought	bought
write	wrote	written
see	saw	seen

2. How Do We Use Past Participles?

A) In the Present Perfect

We use the past participle with have/has to form the Present Perfect:

- **Examples:**
- ✓ I have seen that movie before.
- ✓ She has finished her work.
- ✓ They have never been to Japan.

B) In the Passive Voice

We use the past participle with be (am, is, are, was, were, been, being) to form the passive:

- **Examples:**
- ✓ The book was written by J.K. Rowling.
- ✓ The house has been sold.
- ✓ The cake was made by my grandmother.

C) As an Adjective





Past participles can also be used as adjectives:

- **Examples:**
- ✓ I am tired.
- ✓ The door is closed.
- ✓ She looks confused.

3. Regular vs. Irregular Past Participles

Regular verbs form the past participle by adding -ed

Base Form	Past Simple	Past Participle
play	played	played
work	worked	worked
start	started	started

Irregular verbs have different forms that must be memorized:

Base Form	Past Simple	Past Participle
take	took	taken
speak	spoke	spoken
drink	drank	drunk
