Police Report

Chief McEnerney reported that everything is safe and calm in the Village. However, the surrounding communities have some activity, and the Chief posted a notice on safety practices on the Facebook group for Golf/Golf Acres.

Nothing new to report; however, Sarah looked into the history of both Park and Briar Lane to determine if and/or when a mill and resurface or rebuild might be needed for planning purposes.

Reports

Approval of Bills

Trustee Kalogerakos moved to approve the monthly transaction report for January 2026 as prepared by Village Administrator Michelle Shapiro. Trustee Burden seconded the motion.

Emergency Services Department

Trustee Ross had nothing to report.

Building and Zoning Department

Trustee Burden had nothing to report. She updated the board that construction of 43 Park will most likely be completed by the end of April.

Public Buildings and Grounds Department

Trustee Shine was not present.

Finance and Administration Department

Trustee Miller shared that our financial position remains strong.

The board discussed our tax revenue, the current amount received, and the payments still to be delivered. In addition, the board discussed our consultant, Katherine Andrus, and her ability to serve as the Village Treasurer. President Farr and/or Trustee Miller will reach out to determine if she can serve in that capacity for the Village.

Streets and Sanitation Department

Trustee Kalogerakos reported that the sewer work was completed by RJS Consulting (Ron, the vendor for the signs) at a low cost of \$3,750.

Utilities Department

Trustee Landman shared that we sent letters to each of the 29 residents with lead service lines, in compliance with the EPA notification requirements for 2025. He also clarified that correspondence regarding the Lead Water Service Line Replacement (LSLR) cost-sharing program will be sent to those residents before the next board meeting. Under the Program, the Village will reimburse a qualifying resident 50% of the cost to replace the lead water service line, up to \$5,000.

President's Report

President Farr discussed the 2026 date change for February (3rd Monday of the month) and ensured that all trustees agreed.

President Farr also called for any nominations for the Village of Golf 100 Year Celebration committee. Some nominations have been made, but more are needed for the committee.

He gave an update on the legal matter on Park, sharing that our Village Prosecutor has responded to all correspondence and is waiting for any updates.

Trustee Kalogerakos asked about the park maintenance, and Trustee Landman offered to contact the Village of Glenview in preparation for the spring, clarifying maintenance tasks and standards for the area.

Adjourn

Trustee Kalogerakos moved to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Landman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 7:33 pm.
