

Youth in Harmony Barbershop Festival

Choir students will be attending the Youth in Harmony Barbershop Festival on Thursday, November 7th. This is an all-day event with a concert in the evening. Please make sure to read through all documents sent home. The permission slip is required by the Festival Directors and must be returned to school or the student will not be allowed to attend. Students are to dress comfortably for the day and bring a nice outfit for the performance. No blue jeans or tennis shoes for the evening concert please. A reminder that the concert is on a raised stage and you will be standing on risers, so please avoid short skirts and heels.

The evening concert will be held in the **Bloomington Center for the Performing Arts Auditorium**. Parents, family and friends are encouraged to join us for the evening show. Admission to the show is free but they will be collecting donations. Doors will open at 5:45 PM, and the show will begin promptly at 6:30 PM. We encourage families to arrive early, with the number of students attending the festival, seating is limited.

Schedule for the day:

8:00am – Turn in all homework to teachers for the day

8:20am – Meet in the HS Music Room with all materials for the day

9:00am – Arrive at the Bloomington Center for the Performing Arts and check-in

9:30am – Rehearsals start

Lunch is provided by the YIH Festival. (6" sub sandwich, chips, cookie and drink)

4:30pm – Break – at this point you need to change into your clothes for the evening concert

4:45pm – Load buses and head to dinner (Jersey Mike's, Noodles, Chipotle, etc.)

6:00pm – Return to BCPA for the evening concert

6:30pm – Concert Begins (doors open at 5:45 for audience seating)

8:00pm – Concert ends – load buses and head for home

8:40pm – Arrive back at HHS

What to bring with you:

1. Music and Pencil
2. Nice Clothes for the evening concert – no jeans, t-shirts or tennis shoes
3. Money for dinner (fast food)
