#### GISU Process for Fingerprinting & Background Checks

The GISU just released updated rules for background checks for chaperones, coaches and substitutes. An important point: Fingerprints and background checks are valid for **3 years**. This clarification is a change in our practice. I encourage all parents and community members who want to volunteer as a chaperone, coach, mentor or substitute to make sure you are up-to-date on your GISU background check. The process starts by making an appointment to meet with the appropriate certifier at GISU:

- ★ If you are a substitute or contracted staff member, contact Autumn Rhodes: arhodes@gisu.org

There are ways for you to participate once you have completed the process; however, we cannot make exceptions if your background check is outdated and/or you have not started the process.
