Elegance Technique #1

Hit the Bridge (Coordinating Conjunctions)

When you use this technique, you can make a simple sentence more complex by hitting the bridge with a comma followed by one of the FANBOYS.

F A N B O Y S

Example of just hitting the period: I am a big fan of "The Blacklist".

Example of hitting the bridge: I've been a big fan of "The Blacklist," **and** I love every episode.

Elegance Technique #2

Insert 20:

By simply starting a sentence with one of the following words it instantly makes the sentence have two layers to it.

Before	After	Although	As	Now that
Despite	If	In order	Though	Since
So that	Unless	Until	Even	Besides
When	Where	Whether	While	Because

Example of an insert 20: **Since** I am a baseball coach, I tend to analyze players every time I go to a game.

ELEGANCE TECHNIQUE #3

Juggle Sentence:

By combining your Hit the Bridge and Insert 20 sentences, you make compound-complex sentences.

Example of a juggle sentence: EVEN though grammar is confusing, it helps us understand how we communicate, AND it enhances our ability to craft written text.
