San Andreas Highway Patrol Troopers Stop a State-wide Street Race

INCIDENT DESCRIPTION


Sandy Shores, San Andreas - On Thursday March 21, 2024, at approximately 3:05 PM EST, a street race was organized at the Sandy Shores Airfield. Shortly after, Troopers arrived and started investigating the event. Only seconds passed until the race started and vehicles were fleeing.

Units attempted to pursue different individuals involved. Since many of those vehicles were sports cars, the pursuits were terminated. After BOLOs were set, many of those vehicles were seen in different areas of the state.

Even after law enforcement officers broke up the first race, the individuals did not stop. They organized another race at the same location. This time, Troopers noticed sooner and attempted to stop this. Only to have the suspects take off once again. This continued one more time before things calmed down.

After everything had settled down, many of those vehicles were caught driving throughout the streets. They fled, only to be stopped shortly after by San Andreas Highway Patrol Troopers, and Federal Bureau of Investigation Agents. Four of those said suspects were arrested and charged. The rest remain outstanding and are currently being investigated.
