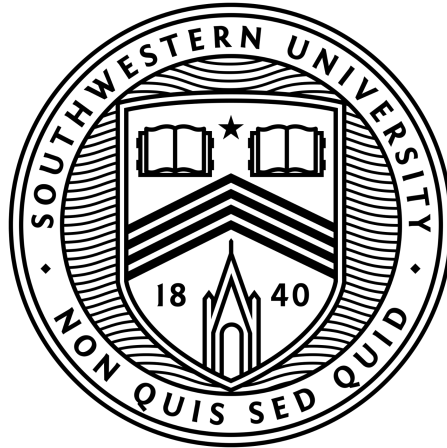

*Be it resolved by the Legislature of the Student Government Association:*

## **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

SHORT TITLE. – This resolution may be cited as the “Composting Resolution”.

## **SECTION 2. FINDINGS.**

Recognizing the benefits of composting and its assistance in attracting beneficial organisms to the soil which reduces the need for pesticides and fertilizers.

Recognizing that the cafeteria does not compost despite the presence of composting signs which would suggest otherwise.

## **SECTION 3. RESOLVED.**

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Southwestern University Student Government Association:

- (1) Composting is affirmed as an important priority for the Southwestern University community and its student body.
- (2) The Student Government Association and Southwestern University administration should, together, establish further support for composting initiatives on campus.
