What's Going On at Highline

1. Our summer institute was very successful. We had two tracks: Upping Your Video Game: Making Videos with Impact! and a book club reading *The Science of Learning Meets AI: A Practical Faculty Guide to Purposeful Integration, Student Engagement, and Ethical Practice* by Lewis D. Ludwig and Todd D. Zakrajsek. Both were run as short-term communities of practice and were well attended. I (Marc) sat in on the book club and the level of engagement was fantastic.
 2. We've added two new positions to our Faculty in Residence. FiR are full time, tenured faculty who are granted release time to be a part of our unit. The new positions are AI Faculty Fellows. They're charged with keeping up/learning advanced uses of AI and then working with faculty to help them manage the impacts of AI on the learning process.
 3. We merged EdTech and our Learning and Teaching Center into a new unit called the Teaching Innovation Development Lab last year, but we're just finally getting to merging web sites, Slack/Teams channels, etc.

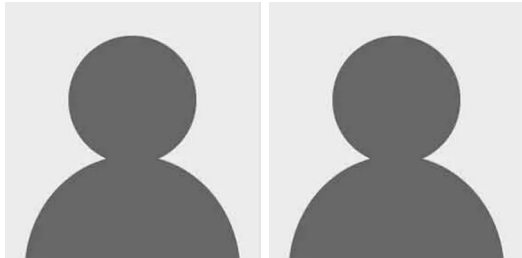
What's Going On at Tacoma

1. Established the TCC Digital Accessibility Workgroup (DAW), co-chaired by Joni Gutierrez and Katie Lee, TCC's new Accessible IT Coordinator. The workgroup brings together broad representation from across the college, including Marketing, Human Resources, Information Technology, Student Services, the Library, Learning Innovation, and other key areas. It is strategically advancing TCC's readiness for the April 2027

compliance deadline while building a permanent and sustainable culture of digital accessibility grounded in the institution's equity and inclusion values.

2. TCC-DAW has also developed a Digital Accessibility Agent within our institutionally protected Microsoft Copilot environment, secured a one-year Adobe Acrobat Pro license to support PDF remediation and accessibility-first document creation, and continues to provide campus-wide training, Canvas accessibility support, advocacy, and professional development.

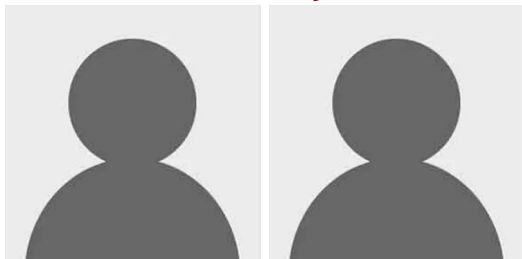

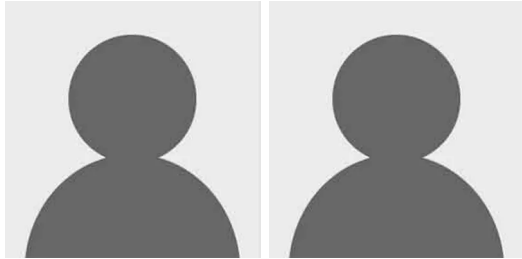

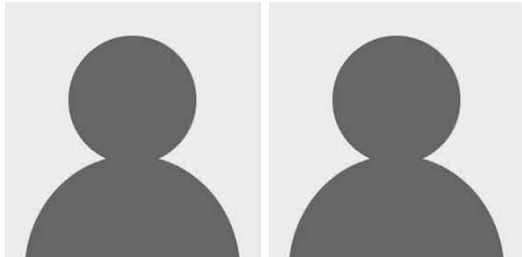
