

Conversation Stack – SALT

It can be hard to get to know people. There are numerous factors opposing us. Convenience, technology, lack of compassion, business...and yet we all want to be known. We can be with people and still not know them.

2 Cor. 5:14-16 "For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died. And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again. So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer."

Three Principles.

1. Be a good listener
2. Build conversation around conversation areas
3. Use conversation expanders! (Who, What, Where, When, Why, How)

The Stack

- 1 Nameplate – my name is...what's yours.
- 2 House – where they live/came from
- 3 Family – Who are your family and friends? What are they like?
- 4 Work glove – major or job
- 5 Airplane – travel , trips taken, places you like to go
- 6 Tennis Racket – Hobbies/sports/activities
- 7 Light Bulb (tie into convo) What do you think about?
- 8 Private First Class (PFC) – Problems, Frustrations, Concerns
- 9 Goal Post – hopes, dreams, goals
- 10 Praying Hands – Christian & Non-Christian. Ask permission. Rom 1:16
