



Geography NCEA Level 2 2025

Course Description:

This course will develop the understanding of Geography as it relates to the NZ Curriculum (level 7). The topics and standards offer ways for students to understand how the processes that shape natural and cultural environments change over time, vary in scale and from place to place and create spatial patterns. Also to understand how people's perceptions of and interactions with natural and cultural environments differ and have changed over time.

Content

Topics covered include:

- Urban Patterns
- New Zealand Geographic issues
- A global Geographic issue
- Aspects of a geographic topic at a global scale
- Conduct Geographic research

Prior Learning Required

Students must have passed the following type of Achievement Standards:

- in Level 1 Geography: 3 internals (9 credit minimum) and 1 external (4 credits) or
- have at least 20 credits in Level 1 English and an interest in the world around them and be prepared to look at other people's points of view and justify their own.
- It is critical for online students to be self-motivated learners who are very good at self-management.
