Position Summary: Receives, inventories, checks, stores, and issues supplies and other materials. Performs minor clerical tasks related to tracking and maintaining an appropriate inventory of the warehouse. Ensures supplies and parts are stored in a safe and appropriate manner. Train new warehouse staff in the standards and procedures of warehouse operations. Performs other duties as assigned. This position is designated as “essential staff” and may be required to work outside their regularly scheduled hours on an as-needed basis.

 - 5+ years of warehouse operations

- **Relationship Management:** Able to personally provide a high level of interactive service to others, building relationships and addressing identified needs.
- **Ethics:** Able to demonstrate integrity, professionalism, civility, and a high degree of ethics in all job-related actions.

- Inspects incoming supplies and equipment for conformity to purchase order specifications.
- Reports shortages, damages, or other discrepancies appropriately.
- Maintains appropriate quantities of supplies by procuring supplies.
- Checks in packages, marks, and arranges packages for timely delivery. ●
- Ensures supplies and parts are stored in a safe and appropriate manner. ●
- Keeps accurate records of items received and delivered.
- Assists with the tracking, pickup, and delivery of district equipment.
- Operates all warehouse equipment in a safe and efficient manner.
- Prepares bid documents and analyzes bid results.
- Communicates with Finance regarding purchase orders.
- Confers with the Asst. Facilities Director regarding staffing and storage space requirements
- Perform other duties as assigned by the direct supervisor or Director of Facilities.
