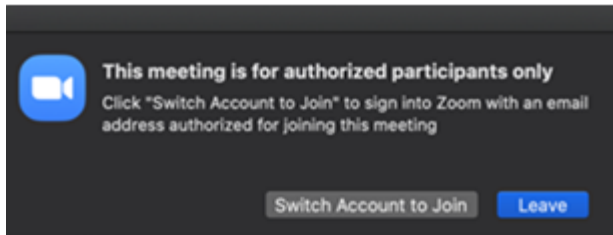


Hello students and families,

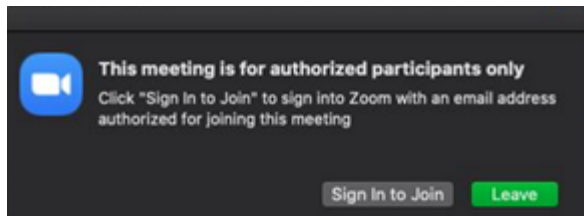
If you log in to a Zoom meeting without an FLVS account, you will see the message below:




Once you have logged in to FLVS as a student, you will see your Zoom account and password at the top of the Educator page. Students can click to reveal their password to be able to log in to Zoom. See image below:



When you click on a Zoom link within Educator, you will be prompted as shown below.



Once you click “Sign In to Join” from your computer or mobile device, you will be asked for your username (Educator email located in the image with Zoom account information) and password (located after the Zoom account email next to key).
