Dear Parents and Guardians of Students Grades 6-11,

The purpose of this letter is to officially notify you of your right to participate in Ohio's College Credit Plus program for the 2026-2027 school year. The program has been established to permit students in grades seven through twelve to earn college and high school graduation credit through the successful completion of college courses. Students electing to participate in this program enroll in and attend college classes either during the regular school day or after school hours. Students may also continue to take classes at Midview Middle School and/or Midview High School, and, in all respects, remain students of the Midview Local School District.

College Credit Plus allows a student to receive both high school and college credit. For public high school students, there is no transfer of tuition between student and college. The high school's state foundation pays the college directly. Public high school students electing this option will not be required to pay for tuition, books, materials or fees. Families will be responsible for tuition costs should a student fail a course or drop a course after the college-established deadlines. Transportation to and from the college and the cost of said transportation is a family responsibility.

The State of Ohio requires that potential CCP participants and their parents attend an informational meeting/counseling session prior to applying for the CCP program. Current CCP students and parents are not required to attend additional meetings; only first time CCP students and their parents are required to attend a meeting. This meeting will be held **Thursday, February 5, 2026 5:30-6:30 pm, Midview High School APR.**

A CCP application is considered complete when students have met the following requirements:

1. Attend a College Credit Plus informational meeting.
2. Submit the required paperwork to your School Counselor (This is necessary to take CCP courses at Midview High School, as well as at LCCC).
3. Request CCP courses during the scheduling process.
4. Complete required placement testing and submit results to your School Counselor.
5. Adhere to all program deadlines as established by the State of Ohio and Midview Local Schools.
