3. How can something small make a big difference in God's kingdom?
4. What kingdoms (ways of life), do people live for in our society?
5. How do these kingdoms differ from God's kingdom?
6. Describe what a group of people living in God's kingdom would be like today.
7. How do you think God's kingdom is like yeast? How does it grow and spread?
8. How might God's kingdom grow and spread in your own life?
9. In what ways might we also be like the Pharisees, concerned with outward appearances, but in fact keeping people from the kingdom of God? How can we change this?
