

## **Playeum's Track Record**

Playeum is a registered charity with an Institution of a Public Character (IPC) status in Singapore that focuses on amplifying the voices and abilities of all children, especially children from disadvantaged backgrounds and those with special needs. Through play and the arts, we create a safe space and equal opportunities for children to develop life skills and the foundations they need to thrive – confidence, resilience and creativity to lead their lives and make meaningful contributions. Playeum is a registered member of the National Council of Social Services (NCSS) and is supported by the National Arts Council (NAC) Cultural Matching Fund.

Over the last 16 years, Playeum has co-developed programmes reaching more than 150,000 children and families through over 300 creative partnerships with social service agencies, schools, cultural institutions and communities. Playeum is humbled to have received nine international awards for innovative cultural work, and successfully travelled its leading work "Transforming Passages" to Artplay, Melbourne through a successful collaboration with the National Museum of Singapore in 2011.

Having gained experience in running the successful Children's Centre for Creativity at Gillman Barracks for five years, Playeum now reaches out to various communities across Singapore with regular, sustainable programmes. In 2017, Playeum's 'Learning Through Play' teacher training course was endorsed by the Early Childhood Development Agency (ECDA) and is ongoing. Currently, teacher training is also conducted within primary schools for PAL and SEL.

#### **Overview of the Charity:**

Playeum Ltd was set up on 17 December 2013 as a public company limited by guarantee. It was registered as a charity under the Charities Act 1994 on 11 August 2014. Playeum Ltd has been accorded IPC (Institution of a Public Character) status since 19 August 2014. Its current IPC term is from 1 January 2023 to 31 December 2025. Playeum has a code of governance as its governing instrument.
