Directions:

- 1. First, put students in pairs. In the perfect world, it would be a heterogeneous pairing. Students work independently to cut out their words and alphabetize them on their own. The cutting should take about five minutes and the alphabetizing should take about 10 minutes.
- 2. The second step is to have the pair work together to alphabetize both lists together.
- 3. Finally, the teacher confirms the two lists are combined together in alphabetical order together.
