




When: Thursday, November 13th, from 8:15-9:15am

<u>Did you know that our Uniform Recycling Program is</u> <u>ongoing...</u>

Throughout the year, donate uniforms that no longer fits your student. What is the uniform recycle process?

- 1. SORT: Go through uniforms and set aside any items that no longer fit but still pass inspection. Be sure to thoroughly check for holes or stains -- we do not want to bless families with clothing that cannot be used. We will accept tops, bottoms, belts, ties...as long as they are in good condition.
- 2. DONATE: Bring the uniform pieces to the front desk in a bag labeled "uniform donation".
- 3. SHOP: Look for periodic Uniform Recycle events or ask to see our collection by emailing ptf@wilberforceschool.org
