- [De Lege Libellum](#): A further explanation of the Book of the Law, with special reference to the Powers and Privileges conferred by its acceptance.
- [Duty](#): A note on the chief rules of practical conduct to be observed by those who accept the Law of Thelema.
- [Stepping Out of the Old Aeon and Into the New](#) by Frater Achad: A short, excellent introduction to Thelemic principles.

Books:

- [The Weiser Concise Guide to Aleister Crowley](#) contains a brilliant short biography and some basic info about Thelema and such.
- [The Revival of Magick](#) contains many short essays by Crowley which attempt to explain his philosophy in more or less plain English prose.
- [The Book of the Law](#) is the received holy text which is at the core of Crowley's teaching.
- [The Law is for All](#) contains much of his commentary on The Book of the Law.
- [Liber Aleph](#) is another important book of commentary on the Law.
- [Perdurabo](#) is the definitive biography of AC. [Churton's Aleister Crowley](#) is also a more readable but less comprehensive biography.

- [Confessions](#) is his autobiography and excellent reading also.
- [Thoth Tarot Deck](#) is Crowley's design and bar none it is the best Tarot deck.
