ABSTRACT

The first abstract must be in English and be between 200-250 words. It should include a brief and clear background, the research problem or topic, objectives, methods, and the conclusion of the research. The format is 11pt, Arial Narrow, justified, single-spaced, and italicized.

Keywords: 3-5 keywords

ABSTRACT

The second abstract is in Indonesian and is 200-250 words long. It must contain a brief and clear background, the research problem or topic, objectives, methods, and the research conclusion. The format is 11pt, Arial Narrow, justified, and single-spaced.

INTRODUCTION

Introduction Sub-section

The introduction section should contain the research background, problem formulation, and research objectives to be achieved in the paper.

METHOD

Method Sub-section

The method section explains the research chronology, data collection procedures, data processing, analysis, and the research method or design used.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Results and Discussion Sub-section

This chapter should present and analyze the results with an emphasis on answering the research problems. Results can be displayed in the form of images, charts, tables, etc., with accompanying explanations.

CONCLUSION

The conclusion should provide an explanation and answer to the research problems. It can also include possibilities for future research development.

REFERENCES

A minimum of 15 references should be included, published within the last 10 years. 80% of these references should come from relevant sources like scientific journals. The citation system must follow the APA format and use a reference

manager software (such as Mendeley or Zotero).

Do not use footnotes for the reference list. Do not include images or anything else after the bibliography. For the bibliography: use 11pt, Arial Narrow, and justified alignment. Indent the text by 1 cm. The bibliography should be typed in its original language.

Book:

Book with multiple authors:

Lead author's last name, Initial. and second author's last name, Initial. (year). Book Title. Publisher name. Publisher location.

Edited Book:

Author's last name, Initial. (year). Article Title. Initial of editor's name [eds]. Edited Book Title. Publisher name. Publisher location.

Journal:

Author's last name, Initial. (year). Article Title, Journal Name, Vol (Number), pages, Journal Publisher Name, Journal Publisher Location.

Conference and Symposium Proceedings (print):

Author's last name, Initial. (year). Article Title. Proceeding of the Conference Name, (pages). Conference Date. Conference Location.

Conference and Symposium Proceedings (online, electronic database):

Author's last name, Initial. (year, Month). Article Title. Paper presented at the Conference Name, (pages). DOI link.
