-It is best to advocate with your personal testimony and communicate with your state and Federal legislators year-round; we rally outside of Washington Seminar, too.

-We are advocating for three bills.

The Access Technology Affordability Act, which would fund a \$2,000 tax credit in order to offset the expenses associated with purchasing access technology.

The Medical Device Nonvisual Accessibility Act, which focuses on personal use devices, such as glucose monitors, blood pressure monitors, etc. Bill advocates for these devices to be made accessible out of the box.

The Transformation to Competitive Integrated *Employment* Act, which eradicates the allowance some companies maintain to pay disabled people subminimum wage.
