## 4. When will you be hosting the event?


a. The drive through pick up for the saplings is currently scheduled on April 13th. The deadline to order is March 13th

#### 6. How tall will the tree be/how will it look when it is first delivered?

a. The sapling will be around 4-6 feet tall. It will be a bare root tree, so there will be no leaves when you first receive it. But don't worry, once the tree is planted and watered, it will begin to sprout branches and leaves. Here is a photo below:
