

Hello AP Students, Families, and AP Teachers!

AP Testing is a little over a week away. Remember, if you earn a 3, 4, or 5 on your exam, that's FREE college credit at many public colleges and universities. Read everything in this message to help prepare and understand AP testing. **Check your email often** so you don't miss any updates or reminders from Mrs. Jablonski or your AP Teacher(s).

READ CAREFULLY

TO DO:

Log in to AP Classroom.

- **Juniors:** When it prompts you to select where to send your scores, bypass this by clicking "I don't want to send my scores."
- **Seniors:** Click on the My AP Profile in the blue section towards the right. Click on Score Send. Indicate the college(s) where you would like your scores to be sent. Click save.
- You will sign the College Board Terms & Conditions agreement before starting the test. Read it in advance here:

IMPORTANT:

- Are you taking **Biology, Computer Science A, Physics 1, Physics 2, or Statistics?** If so, your test ends *after* 2:40pm. As there are no late buses, ***you must pre-arrange any transportation.*** If you work, you'll need to forgo taking any shifts that start before about 4:30 pm.
- **Athletes,** let your coach know if you will be late or miss practice or a meet/game.
- If you are taking **2 tests** in one day, you may bring a lunch to have between exams.
- Students taking **afternoon exams** will need to go to 1st lunch due to the 11:40 report time.
- CAA/CTC students--please talk with your teachers if there is a conflict with your CAA/CTC schedule and your AP exam.
- Remind family and friends that you won't be able to access cell phones or smart watches during the test AT ALL, even during breaks.
- If you have a conflict with testing (e.g. medical procedure, IB exam conflict, etc.) **contact Mrs. Jablonski ASAP** so we can determine if you are eligible for make-up testing. Things like "I'm scheduled to work at that time," "I didn't sleep well last night," or "I have to babysit" are not accepted. *This is a College Board rule, not a Shawnee Mission Northwest rule.*

TEST-TAKING TIPS:

- Attend ALL regular class periods of your AP classes and non-AP classes—DON'T SKIP OR TAKE LONG BATHROOM BREAKS. Form study groups where you practice FRQs or review other topics. Ask your teachers if they will be holding any “boot camps” or study sessions outside of class time, and attend those sessions.
- Get good sleep the night before your test. Eat a good breakfast the morning of your test.

STUDY HELP:

AP Daily: Practice Sessions is a new video series that provides students with opportunities to practice applying course content and skills to actual multiple-choice and free-response questions.

- **Bring to the test room:**

- ☐ Sharpened No. 2 pencils (not mechanical)
- ☐ Dark blue or black ink pens
- ☐ Ruler for Physics
- ☐ Calculator for Bio, Calc, Chem, & Physics
 - ☐ (see calculator rules
<https://apstudents.collegeboard.org/exam-policies-guidelines/calculator-policies>)
- ☐ Layers of comfy clothing (it could be very hot or very cool in the room)
- ☐ Medical items (e.g. inhaler, period products, tissues, masks, etc.)
- ☐ Water bottle/snack
- ☐ A watch that does not have internet access or make any noise

- **Not allowed in test room:**

- ☐ Backpack, notes, folders, books, protractors, compasses, paper, mechanical
 - ☐ pencils, white-out, markers, highlighters, or colored pencils.
- ☐ Earplugs, earbuds, or headphones.
- ☐ Cell phones, smart watches, personal computers/tablets, fitness
 - ☐ trackers, cameras, headphones, or recording devices. This is official
 - ☐ College Board policy—not just SM West rules. Test proctors will collect

- ☐ and securely store your powered-off device and return it to you at the end of the test.
- ☐ Clothing that has info about the subject you are taking a test for.

You'll have a short, scheduled break during the exam when you can access water, snacks, and the restroom. There will be no phone access until all exams are collected.

AFTER TESTING

If you are taking a morning test, you will attend your afternoon classes and have lunch as normal. If you miss your scheduled lunch due to the exam then you will have lunch after your exam and then attend your afternoon classes.

After testing, you cannot share anything about the exam, including by chat or by posting about test questions on social media. You cannot take any part of the test out of the room, including scratch paper.

After College Board representatives have graded your exam(s), the results will be available online in **July**. Scores could be canceled if there is any suspicion or evidence of cheating.

When you score a 3, 4, or a 5, you'll want to send these scores to any colleges you are applying to! In Kansas, most of our state colleges and universities accept these scores as college credit but the amount of credit awarded varies.
