EOIR announced via Twitter on August 24, 2020 at 10:19am (ET) that "Non-detained hearings at the Honolulu Immigration Court are postponed through, and including, August 31, 2020. Please monitor EOIR's website for information about the agency's operations nationwide."	
EOIR announced via Twitter on July 26, 2020 at 11:00pm (ET) that "Due to Hurricane Douglas, the Honolulu Immigration Court will be closed tomorrow."	
	On June 23, 2020, Senator Mazie Hirono (D-Hawaii) joined 11 other Senators in sending a letter to EOIR Director McHenry about EOIR's decision to resume non-detained hearings, its process for making that decision, and its communication of that decision to stakeholders. The Honolulu Immigration Court resumed non-detained cases on June 15, 2020, and according to EOIR's announcement , the agency will "resume individual merits hearings and master calendar dockets involving relatively small numbers of respondents."
EOIR announced via Twitter on June 15, 2020, at 10:45 am (ET) • (1/3) "As previously announced, the Honolulu Immigration Court resumed non-detained hearings today. The Boston, Buffalo, Dallas, Hartford, Las Vegas, Memphis, and New Orleans Immigration Courts will resume non-detained hearings on June 29." • (2/3) "Hearings in non-detained cases at all other immigration courts are postponed through, and including, Thursday July 2, 2020. All immigration courts will be closed Friday, July 3, 2020, in observance of Independence Day." • (3/3) "Visit EOIR's web page for the latest operational status of courts nationwide. On June 11, 2020, EOIR posted the following announcement for Honolulu Immigration Court: “On June 15, 2020, the Executive Office for Immigration Review (EOIR) plans to resume individual (merits) non-detained hearings as scheduled. The agency will also resume master calendar dockets involving relatively small numbers of respondents.”	
EOIR announced via Twitter on June 11, 2020, at 8:28 pm (ET) – “Please check the Honolulu Immigration Court's web page for a notice that was posted today regarding the resumption of non-detained hearings at that location.” EOIR linked to the Honolulu Immigration Court page in the tweet.	
EOIR announced via Twitter on May 29, 2020, at 3:34 pm (ET), that “The Honolulu Immigration Court will resume hearings in non-detained cases on Monday, June 15, 2020. Hearings in non-detained cases at other immigration courts are postponed through, and including, Friday, June 26, 2020. Please monitor EOIR's web page for additional information.” EOIR sent this update via email on May 29, 2020, at 3:31 pm (ET).	
EOIR announced via Twitter on March 17, 2020, at 11:55 pm (ET) that “Effective March 18 all non-detained hearings postponed: these immigration courts closed: ATL Peachtree, Charlotte; HOU Gessner; Louisville; Memphis; NYC, Broadway & Fed Plaza; Newark; Sacramento; LOS – Olive. Check website for updates.”	Also see EOIR issued a press statement on March 18, 2020, at 12:30 am (ET).
