Battery Power & Charging Options

The FORTEM tyre inflator operates on 12V DC power from a vehicle's power outlet and runs via a corded connection (14ft cable), so it does not have a built-in rechargeable battery.

The inflator includes two charging or power methods in the sense that it can be plugged into a car's 12V outlet or a compatible AC adapter for home use, but it requires constant connection to a power source during operation.

It delivers continuous operation powered directly by the car's electrical system, providing consistent inflation capability for most basic tyre inflation tasks.

Pressure Capabilities & Speed Performance

With 150 PSI maximum pressure, the FORTEM inflator handles basic automotive requirements adequately. Car tyres typically need 30–35 PSI, while road [bikes](#) might require 100+ PSI—the unit covers these applications with reasonable effectiveness.

Inflation speed remains moderate; it increases a car tyre from 28 to 35 PSI in approximately 2–3 minutes, while a completely [flat tyre](#) requires 6–8 minutes to fill properly. This isn't the fastest performance available, but proves quick enough for basic roadside situations when you need to get moving again.

Size, Weight & Portability

At 0.85 kg (with dimensions of approximately 20.32 cm x 15.24 cm x 7.62 cm), the unit fits in most boot spaces without creating storage issues. It's also made of lightweight plastic that makes it quite durable.

Digital Display & Control Features

The LCD screen displays pressure readings in PSI, BAR, KPA, or kg/cm² formats with reasonable visibility, even at night conditions. You can set target pressure levels, and the unit stops automatically when reaching the preset level.

Attachment System & Compatibility

You receive three nozzles with the FORTEM:

- Standard connector for car tyres
- Needle attachment for sports balls
- Cone adapter for [air mattresses](#)

They connect through a push-and-twist system that works adequately, though the connections can feel somewhat loose compared to professional-grade equipment.

Price & What You Get

The FORTEM costs between £25 and £35 depending on where you shop. That's slightly more than basic corded models (£20–£30) but less than professional shop inflators (£120+).

What's Included in the Package

The full kit comes with the inflator unit, three different nozzle attachments, an extra fuse, a convenient carrying case, and a detailed instruction manual. The cables, which extend up to 4.27 metres (or 14 feet), are neatly stored within the compact design of the device.

Warranty & Return Policy

FORTEM provides a 1-year warranty against manufacturing defects along with a 30-day return period if you're unsatisfied with performance. However, this return period is significantly shorter compared to other brands like Ordiniq, which offers a comprehensive 90-day money-back guarantee that provides more time to properly test the product in real-world conditions.

The limited 30-day window means you need to evaluate the FORTEM quickly after purchase, whereas longer return periods allow for thorough testing across different seasons and usage scenarios.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Must the FORTEM inflator be plugged while using?

Yes, the FORTEM inflator must be connected to a 12V DC power outlet in your vehicle to be used. However, if you have a cordless model with a built-in battery, operating on battery power provides more mobility without cable restrictions. For corded models, constant connection to the car's power supply is required during inflation.

What is the maximum tyre size this inflator can handle effectively?

The FORTEM handles tyres up to light truck/SUV size (approximately 33" diameter) adequately.

How accurate is the digital pressure gauge on the FORTEM inflator?

The gauge typically stays within 1.5 PSI of professional gauges across different pressure levels, which proves adequate for normal use and beats most petrol station pumps. For racing or performance cars where every PSI matters, you might want to double-check with a separate precision gauge.
