- NOTICE TO PLAYERS - REGISTRATION: **** IMPORTANT ****

All players are required to register in person or by calling the IWGA dedicated registration phone line at (815) 200-9204 on Monday, September 18, from 11am to 3pm.

RULES: USGA Rules and the IWGA Hard Card will govern play. **Players are responsible for being familiar with all conditions of the IWGA Hard Card.**

PACE OF PLAY: See separate IWGA Pace of Play Policy. **Players are responsible for being familiar with all conditions of the IWGA Pace of Play Policy.**

CODE OF CONDUCT: See separate IWGA Code of Conduct. **Players are responsible for being familiar with all conditions of the IWGA Code of Conduct.**

LIGHTNING POLICY: See separate IWGA Lightning Policy. **Players are responsible for being familiar with all conditions of the IWGA Lightning Policy.**

MOTORIZED CARTS: All players must utilize the carts provided. Caddies are not allowed and players are not allowed to carry or otherwise transport their clubs. A motorized cart is considered part of the player's equipment.

TEE MARKERS: Play will be from the RED tee markers

PROVISIONAL BALL: If you believe your ball is lost outside a penalty area or is out of bounds, to save time you may play another ball provisionally under Rule 18.3. You **MUST** inform your opponent or fellow competitors that you intend to play a provisional ball.

PENALTY AREAS: Defined by red/yellow painted lines and indicated by red/yellow stakes.

Hole #2, #3, #6, #7, #8, #9, #13, #15, #16

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by White Stakes

OB: #5, #6, #9, #10, #11, #12, #14 .

Driving Range—in play on #1, OB on #9

SHELTERS: Located near holes 3/6 and 12/15 green

TIES: Any tie for first place in Championship Flight will be determined by a sudden death playoff. All other ties will be determined by scorecard playoff using USGA recommendations (last 9, last 6, etc.). **A player who is involved in a playoff must be on property, ready to play at the start of the playoff or she will be eliminated from the playoff.**

SUSPENSION OF PLAY: Should play be discontinued for a dangerous situation, most players on the course should immediately proceed to the clubhouse. Players within close proximity of the shelters may seek shelter there if they feel they are too far from the clubhouse to travel there safely.

Signals:

- Immediate Discontinuance of Play (dangerous situation).....One long blast of horn
- Discontinuance of Play (non-dangerous situation).....Three blasts of horn
- Resume Play.....Two blasts of horn

RULES CARTS: Rules carts will be on the course at all times. One will be roving on the front, and one on the back. Other carts will be positioned as needed.
