

BARRON SCOTT LEVKOFF

Sex-Positive Community Builder, Experience Designer & Event Producer

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For 17 years, Barron Scott Levkoff was a pioneering force in San Francisco's sex-positive community — designing, producing, and curating events and spaces that center consent, creativity, body autonomy, and the radical potential of authentic human connection. His work spans immersive theater, adult carnival culture, sensory play, erotic art showcases, and community celebration, consistently holding space for the full spectrum of human expression with care, artistry, and joy.

PHILOSOPHY & APPROACH

Scott approaches sex-positive event design through the lens of “social artistry” — the intentional crafting of environments where guests feel safe, celebrated, and free to explore. His events are distinguished by meticulous attention to atmosphere, clear community agreements, inclusive and intersectional values, and a playful irreverence that makes the erotic feel celebratory rather than transgressive. He brings the same production rigor and creative depth to adult spaces that he applies to large-scale corporate immersive experiences.

Exotic Erotic Ball — San Francisco, CA — *Fetish & Burlesque Programming / VIP Lounge Producer*

During the final years of the legendary Exotic Erotic Ball — one of the largest and most iconic adult events in San Francisco history — Scott Levkoff served as the producer responsible for bringing fetish and burlesque content to the event, and for producing the exclusive VIP Lounge experience. The VIP Lounge hosted approximately 1,500 guests across an evening featuring around 100 performers on 6 stages, delivering a curated high-production adult entertainment environment within the larger event. Scott's work encompassed performer casting and direction, stage and environment design, programming flow, and the overall guest experience of the VIP space — ensuring that the final chapters of this storied San Francisco institution closed with the artistry and ambition the event's legacy deserved.

Masquerotica — San Francisco, CA

Coproducer and creative director to Masquerotica, San Francisco's erotic masked ball. The event brought together thousands of guests for an evening of costumed sensuality, performance art, and community celebration. Scott's involvement spans production design, immersive environment creation, and atmospheric storytelling.

Kinky Salon — San Francisco, CA — *Co-Founder*

Co-founded Kinky Salon as part of the Mission Control community hub, one of San Francisco's most celebrated sex-positive gathering spaces. Kinky Salon grew from an intimate community night into a globally recognized sex-positive event brand with chapters worldwide, known for its emphasis on consent culture, creative costuming, and inclusive community values.

Mission Control — San Francisco, CA — *Co-Founder, 2001–2014*

Co-founded and operated Mission Control, a community-centric event space and collective that served as the creative home for a constellation of sex-positive, kink-affirming, and body-positive events including Kinky Salon, Club Kiss, and Crushlab. Mission Control helped define the culture and aesthetic of SF's early 2000s sex-positive renaissance.

Club Kiss — San Francisco, CA — *Co-Founder*

Co-founded Club Kiss as part of the Mission Control family of events — a sensual, community-driven social night designed around connection, play, and body celebration in a safe, consent-forward environment.

Crushlab — *San Francisco, CA — Co-Founder*

Co-founded Crushlab, an intimate and playful social experiment in consensual flirtation and human connection — blending social game design with sex-positive community values to create evenings of charged, joyful interaction.

Sea of Dreams — *San Francisco, CA — Founder, 1999*

Produced and directed the inaugural Sea of Dreams, which grew into one of San Francisco's most beloved and long-running New Year's Eve celebrations, spanning 20 years. The event was celebrated for its immersive design, inclusive atmosphere, artistic ambition, and its embrace of the full spectrum of human expression — including erotic art, body painting, and sensual performance.

Mission Control — *San Francisco, CA*

Over more than a decade, Scott helped steward a community collective that became foundational to SF's sex-positive ecosystem — mentoring emerging producers, modeling consent culture in event design, and creating lasting infrastructure for adult community gathering.
