As someone who's lived since the existence of nature and was subsequently spawned from it, they hold a very different set of morals. They will not pursue actively killing people unless they in return were actively harming life. For them, killing is simply another part of nature. “From earth, all life spawns, and to earth they shall return,” is a common phrase uttered from

their lips. They view it as little more than maintaining the natural order, akin to a gardener pruning their plants to keep them healthier. As such, they also do not attempt to make killing actively painful, and to the contrary, try to grant as much of a 'pure' release as they can - to the extent of their beliefs. Strangely enough, while they will react quite strongly if other lifeforms are being harmed, attempts to harm Ljómi themselves will elicit little more than a passive evasion of any such attacks, and they will most likely not retaliate with lethal force.

Their goals seem to be aimed towards maintaining a balance within all life, and any such actions or journeys they take in their own bodies are little more than pursuing that equilibrium. Whether it takes them to one side of the world or the other, Ljómi seems to have a penchant for appearing where it would befit them well. Currently, they are watching the development of Yggdrasil and the return of the budding guild Cherry Heart. Whether one may consider Ljómi an ally or an enemy is up to fate and their own actions.

Abilities:

The Consecrated Earth upon which the Undying Blossoms of Heaven Flourish Eternal:

Ljómi's existence is interwoven with nature and the lifestream, and for that reason, "they" cannot truly perish as long as anything true to the original world remains. However, unlike other "immortal" beings, their current form will still perish like any other if they are successfully killed. At that point, a new "Ljómi" will begin to grow in the form of a flower somewhere in the world. Upon reaching maturity, the bud will be of a massive size, from which the newly born Ljómi will step forth, with the memories of their past forms retained.

The primary manifestation of this ability however, takes another form - or rather, many more forms. At its base, it is [creation of new life](#) in the truest meaning. Ljómi can birth life out of seeds he can create, by using his own immense pool of mana to shape and give birth to it. The life that is created is as real and true to nature as any other life that has ever existed, and is fully capable of reproduction if left to its devices. Ljómi has immense control over the properties and behaviors of the new beings, which can take on seemingly impossible levels due to being defined and created by magic. As a result, he has great variety of beings he had created throughout the ages thanks to being able to experiment for so long.

As Ljómi travels around the world, he oft leaves behind sanctuaries in the wild, where his mystical flora and fauna intersperse and integrate with the wild, giving rise to wondrous, yet almost alien ecosystems. The main way he wields this power seems to be something akin to gardening or restoration, however, this power can be used in combat as well, thanks to its incredible versatility. When not actively restoring the world to its natural order, he will often be in one of his many such “gardens” around the world, cultivating and tenderly taking care of the life he had given birth to.

While Ljómi must create a seed and then direct a flow of mana to it to actually create the plants, this is a process that can be done fairly quickly, which could lead people to mistake it as the plants coming out of thin air. This allows for the seeds to be pre-planted as well if he wishes, to mature later. If planted in viable earth, they can last for as long as Ljómi desires (although he will usually germinate it within at least a week). If planted inside a living being, it will disappear on its own within about six hours.

Between offense, defense, and utility, the application of this ability in combat is limited to naught but the imagination and mana reserves. Razor-sharp partially formed branches blasting forth, or even creating a monstrous predatory creature to assist him yields itself to the first category. Thick and tangled vines and tree trunks can create sturdy walls, and strangulating roots bursting from the depths of the earth itself can snare enemies. With the aforementioned seeds, they add another aspect of potential danger, as Ljómi can fire them similar to a bullet. Once a seed enters a living being, it will open the possibility of it being used to tear apart the being from the inside by spawning a large or deadly plant from the seed. As with just about every other

application of magic though, the more complex or massive something is, the more time and mana it takes to create. Still, it would not be a wise decision to underestimate Ljómi.

This ability can lend itself to travel, but this is solely used for getting to places, and would not be viable as any sort of escape from an active chase. While it is a good deal faster than conventionally walking across the land would, it is still nowhere close to instant, and Ljómi becomes relatively vulnerable while preparing to travel. This is done by the same concept of his rebirth, where a large blossom will sprout from the ground slowly, before wrapping himself in its leaves. Once that is done, a matching blossom will flourish from the earth of another location and budding forth to reveal Ljómi. There are several limitations to this ability however. He can only travel like this once every few hours, and any such transport-blossoms are limited to a single use before they disappear into the wind as ash. In addition, he can only travel to places where there is at least a sizable amount of natural life. Therefore, he cannot travel to somewhere such as the midst of a city unless there is a large forest or the similar on the borders. This is how Ljómi usually travels around the world to quickly get from place to place as needed to monitor and protect the wild.
