

✨ My Story: A Testimony Writing Guide for Junior High Students ✨

Purpose:

This guide will help you prayerfully reflect, organize your thoughts, and write your personal testimony — your story of how you've seen Jesus work in your life.

🙏 Step 1: Begin with Prayer

Take a moment to pray. Ask God:

“Lord, help me remember where I’ve seen You in my life. Help me be honest, brave, and clear as I write my story.”

🧠 Step 2: Brainstorming My Story

Fill out each section honestly. There are no wrong answers — this is your story!

1. My Life Before I Knew Jesus (or Before I Took My Faith Seriously)

- What did I believe about God?

- How did I handle hard things?

- What was missing in my life?

2. How I Met Jesus

- Was there a moment, message, camp, or conversation that made Jesus real to me?

- What did I feel or realize?

- Who helped me understand the Gospel?

3. What I Believe About Jesus

- Who is Jesus to me now?
- What do I believe He did for me?
- How do I know He is real?

4. My Life After I Chose Jesus

- How has my heart, attitude, or choices changed?
- What's different now that I walk with God?
- Is life easier or just more hopeful?

5. Bible Verses That Describe My Story

- Pick 1–2 verses that represent your story or what God has done in your life.
- Some ideas: 2 Corinthians 5:17, Romans 5:8, Psalm 34:4, Galatians 2:20, John 3:16, Philippians 1:6

Step 3: Write Out Your Testimony

Now, use your notes to write your story. Keep it simple, honest, and about 3–5 paragraphs long. Start by saying:

"This is my story about how Jesus changed my life..."
