



Community Guidelines

The following guidelines are adapted from several organizations running kink- and queer-friendly parties across the globe, including Gender Bending Cruise Party, Latex MTL, and Sextou London.

RavePartyMachine celebrates sexuality in all its forms, regardless of orientation. It is especially important that transgender people and BIPOC attendees feel safe, respected, and welcomed. Our lineup is intentionally curated to reflect these values. We also offer significant discounts - and where needed, complimentary admission - to marginalized groups. You can access this through the "community ticket" option at checkout on Resident Advisor. If you have already purchased a ticket we thank you for your support and can offer a further discount for a future party.

We ask everyone attending Hyperfuck to actively participate in creating a safer, more inclusive space for gender, sexuality, and all forms of diversity. You are part of this environment, and your awareness matters. If anything feels off please alert staff immediately.

This is not a play party.

There is no dungeon and no sex is permitted anywhere on the premises.

There is a dress code.

Acceptable: kink fashion, goth, punk, pup, furry, cosplay, latex, leather, lolita, kandi raver, haute couture, and other outfits where effort was clearly made.

Not acceptable: normal street clothes.

The dress code will be enforced more strictly than the first Hyperfuck.

Consent is paramount.

Always ask for consent. If you don't, you may be asked to leave.

Approach people face-to-face - never from the side or behind - and look for an enthusiastic "yes." Consent can be withdrawn or changed at any time.

Examples of when to ask for consent:

- Before giving a compliment: "Do you mind if I compliment your appearance?"
- Before adjusting something on someone: "You've got a bit of fluff in your hair—may I help remove it?"
- Before touching or dancing: Approach from the front and ask, "Would you like to dance?" and look for an enthusiastic yes.

People often find this approach more respectful and attractive - and it leads to better, more genuine interactions.

**No leering, creeping, following, or insisting**

Leering is defined as looking or gazing in a lascivious or uncomfortable way. This behavior is not tolerated at Hyperfuck.

Responsibility for your guests

At Hyperfuck, you are responsible for the behavior of those you bring. You may be held accountable for their actions, so please invite them thoughtfully and help maintain a safe environment for everyone.

Zero tolerance policy

We have zero tolerance for verbal or physical harassment, including racism, xenophobia, sexism, transphobia, homophobia, ageism, fatphobia, or any other forms of discrimination.

Phone and camera policy

No photos, videos, or cellphone use are permitted inside the venue. A designated photographer will be present and will ask for consent before taking any photos. These may be shared publicly on social media after the event. We will only share 'sexy' 'edgy' photos if consent was granted. If its a crowd photo a reasonable adult would agree to be shared - we will share without confirming beforehand. Please trust our judgement.
