

WIDAFIL 2022 Abstract Submission Details

Instructions for Submission

- All WIDAFIL 2022 papers should be submitted via the Microsoft CMT Conference System. Please follow the instructions on the submission website carefully, to ensure that your paper has been submitted correctly. Final submission to be done [here](#)
- Only abstract to be submitted for the workshop. Paper submission for Post-Workshop proceedings comes later. Check Important Dates section [here](#)
- Papers should be formatted according to the instructions and style files provided by Springer Overleaf Template [here](#)
- If you encounter any problem during the paper submission process and cannot resolve it, please contact the Program Chairs.
- WIDAFIL 2022 will follow a double-blind review process. Authors should not include their names or affiliations anywhere in the manuscript.
- The team size of Authors should be a maximum of 3 individuals
- Each abstract submission requires at least one author to have performed an ICFHR 2022 onsite registration as author or student whichever is suitable for the purpose.

- Reviewer names will also not be visible to authors.
- Both submissions of new papers and updates of already submitted ones are welcome until the submission deadline.
- At least one author of each accepted paper MUST register the paper at full rate. Papers without a confirmed registration will be withdrawn by the conference organizers.
- Papers accepted for the conference will be allocated up to 8 pages in the proceedings, including references. Submissions are expected to be 6-8 pages long.
- The author response phase will take place after the first round of reviews. It is optional and meant to provide authors with an opportunity to correct factual errors in a review, or to supply additional information as requested by reviewers. It is not intended as an opportunity to add new contributions.

IAPR Ethical Requirements for Authors

The IAPR requires that all authors wishing to present a paper declare that:

- The paper is substantially original and no paper substantially similar in content has been submitted or will be submitted to any other conference or journal during the review period.
- The paper does not contain any plagiarism.
- The paper will be presented by the author or a co-author in person.
- The IAPR retains the right to eliminate any papers in violation of these requirements and to exclude the authors of such papers from future IAPR community activities.
