## **Dress Code**

Clover Middle School promotes and believes in appropriate dress for our students during school hours, events and anytime students are officially representing our school. The school faculty, staff, and administration reserve the

right to determine what is appropriate dress or accessory while students are in school.	
EXPECTATIONS	Examples
Tops:  Tops should provide adequate coverage and extend far enough so that there is no skin exposed at any point of a student's movement or posture.  The width of straps on tops must be at least the width of three fingers.  The following are not permitted:  Visible undergarments nor items worn as undergarments including bras, bikini tops, etc.  Strapless tops/spaghetti straps  Midriff-exposing tops  Trench coats  See-through or mesh tops	Not Approved
Bottoms:  Measurement using fingertips when standing upright, shorts or bottom hem must come to the bottom of the thumb.  Bottoms must be worn from the waistline or above. Short pants must be visible under tops.  The following are not permitted:  Visible undergarments nor items worn as undergarments  Holes in garments or exposed skin above the required length of bottoms  Pajama bottoms  Bottoms adorned with metal or plastic chain, handcuffs, or other accessories	Approved Not Approved And white a series of the series of
The following are not permitted:	

## The following are not permittea:

Chains and spiked accessories of any kind Hoods, hats, sweatbands, or other head coverings in the school building

Retractable skates or bedroom slippers

Clothing with vulgar, obscene, or inappropriate symbols, language, or wording

Clothing with reference to drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, violence, sexual behavior, or any other inappropriate message

Gang-related colors and paraphernalia including bandanas, rags, etc.

Eye-glasses with dark tinted lenses inside the building except for medical situations with proper documentation





- > The school reserves the right to confiscate prohibited items.
- > Students may be required to remove jewelry for class activities that could result in injury.
- > Students are responsible for securing all items removed for safety reasons.
- > Students who violate the dress code will be referred to STOP and offered an available change of clothing OR allowed to call home for a change of clothing. Students will remain in the STOP room until alternate attire is acquired.
- > Dress code violations are entered into the school database as discipline infractions.
