## **8th Grade Events**



Dear Parents and Eighth Grade Students,

It is time to look ahead to the end of the year's eighth-grade activities. Each activity is outlined below. In order to plan for student attendance at these two events, ASB is offering money-saving bundled presale packages.

**All tickets and permission slips are due by 4:00 PM on Friday, May 8th, 2026.**

### **8th Grade Semi-Formal Dance**

The annual 8th Grade Semi-Formal Dance is scheduled for Friday, May 29th, 2026 from 7:30 pm – 9:00 pm at Niguel Hills Middle School. A semi-formal dress is requested for this dance. Copies of the dress code are attached.

- Theme: “A Night in New York City”
- For planning purposes, strapless dresses and tuxedos are not appropriate.
- The dance is ONLY for Niguel Hills Middle School eighth-grade students in good standing.
- Once students are admitted to the dance, they are not permitted to leave until the conclusion of the dance.
- Dance will include DJ, games, photo booth, and snacks!

### **8th Grade Boomers Trip**

- The 8th Grade Trip is scheduled to take place on **Wednesday, June 3rd from 10:00 am – 4:45 pm.**

Students will be transported by bus from Niguel hills to Boomer's in Irvine.

- Busses will pick up at 4:45 PM and drop off at NHMS at approximately 5:15 pm
- Students must provide their own transportation home from school once they return to NHMS.
- All students going to Boomers will receive the following:
  - Access to all major attractions including: Go Carts, Mini Golf, the Arcade, Laser Tag, and the various rides available at the park
  - 40 Arcade Credits (More can be purchased at the front desk)
- Tickets do not include access to the batting cages but this can be purchased at the front desk as well
- Students will be permitted to bring a small bag to Boomer's with them to carry personal items. This bag will be subject to search before getting on the buses.
- Students will not be allowed to bring a water bottle. Waters will be provided to students when we arrive at the park.

### **General Information:**

- Students with behavior problems (5 or more demerits) will not be able to participate.
- Students who have had unacceptable behavior as noted by the Administration will not be able to participate.
- Students who have had unacceptable behavior as noted by the Activities Director will not be able to participate.
- Parents must fill out and sign the permission slips for both activities before the event.
- Permission slips can be turned in to the front office.
- All students have been informed of school and district expectations and policies throughout the year. Students have been following these standards and expectations of conduct while on campus and must continue to do so in order to participate in the activities mentioned above.

### **Leaving Early Important Notes:**

- A note/email is required for any student who is going to be picked up early from Boomers and must be given with advanced notice
  - The only early pick-up time will be 1:00 PM at the park entrance. For safety reasons, there is

only one opportunity to pick up your child early. If you do not pick up your child at 1:00 pm, your child will be transported back to school with the rest of the students.

- **The note/email must be sent to Mr. Stone and approved by 5/23.**

- The students leaving early will meet Mr. Stone at the chaperone tables at 1:00 pm.
- A note/email is required for any student who is going to be picked up early from the **DANCE** and must be given with advanced notice.
  - The note/email must be sent to Mr. Stone and approved by 5/23.

## **8th Grade Semi-Formal Dance Dress Code**

### **The dress code for the dance must be followed:**

- **Violations:** Students in violation of the dress code will either need a new change of clothes brought to the school or they will be requested to leave.
- Once students are admitted into the activity or dance, they may not alter their attire. If they do, they will be removed from the activity or dance, parents will be notified to pick them up, and they will not be permitted to attend Boomers.
- All attire must follow the school dress code.
- Dresses must have straps- asymmetrical straps, clear straps, and sewn-in straps are okay.
- Clothes must cover the midriff.
- Dresses should not be low cut at the neckline.
- No exposed undergarments.
- No sheer or see-through dresses, and no see-through sides or bare sides.
- Attire that is so tight it rides up when walking is not permitted.
- Heels are allowed, but keep in mind that shoes must be worn at all times. Flats are recommended for this reason. (Vans, Converse, or sandals are a good option)
- No shorts
- No sagging pants.
- No T-Shirts
- Accessories such as hats, bandanas, chains, or canes are not allowed.

## POLICIES AGREEMENT AND PERMISSION SLIPS

### NHMS Eighth Grade End of Year Activities

**POLICIES:**

- Students may use their cell phones to take pictures with the expressed permission of those appearing in the photos. Students who choose to bring and use cell phones at the dance and 8th-grade trip to Boomers do so at their own risk.
- Dress code: Any student who is violating the dress code will be given the option of having new clothes brought to school or going home. Any student whose attire violates the dress code after entering the dance/Boomers will be removed from the activity and parents will be required to come pick them up. No refunds will be given if removed from the dance or Boomers
- Students who attend Boomers not under the supervision of NHMS will have an unexcused absence. NHMS is not responsible for the supervision or safety of any students not traveling to Boomers with the school.
- Students must stay within the park during the field trip. Students may not exit the park through the gate to go to outside restaurants or shops.
- Once students enter the dance, they must stay for the entire dance. Unless other arrangements have been made and approved by the Administration or Mr. Stone
- Parents will be required to come and pick up any student who is misbehaving at the dance or at the eighth-grade trip. No refunds will be given if the student has to be removed from an 8th-grade activity.
