What do online viewers need to participate? As long as you have a strong internet connection, you'll be able to view the event. You will receive a viewing link/password by email Friday, Oct 22nd and 1 hour before the event starts. Tech support will be available throughout the day if you have trouble logging on.

If you're hosting a watch party, you will need a streaming device that connects your television/projector/laptop to the internet to display the online event content.

Does everyone in my group need a ticket? Yes! Each person will need to purchase their own ticket to access online content, including post-event resources. Attendees will have access to event content through Friday, November 5th. A link to the event replay will be provided in the post-event email.

Can I watch the event later? Yes, a replay of event content will be available through Friday, November 5th. You will receive an email containing a link to the replay on Tuesday, October 26th.
