

United States: Colonial & Revolutionary Periods

- **The Printing Press in the Colonies:** How the spread of local news innovated political thought and influenced the move toward independence.
- **Smallpox Inoculation (1721):** Cotton Mather and Zabdiel Boylston's innovation in medicine that impacted survival rates during colonial outbreaks.
- **Franklin's Lightning Rod:** A scientific innovation that changed how humans viewed natural forces and influenced modern safety.
- **The Committees of Correspondence:** An organizational innovation that allowed colonies to communicate instantly, impacting the unity of the revolution.
