Welcome Week Activities for Students

As teachers engage in professional learning, students will have access to differentiated, standards-based activities that build skills for online learning, develop social emotional skills, engage in content standards and provide an opportunity for voice and choice. These stand alone, student-centered activities will be distributed by teachers through their <u>online platforms</u>. During morning meetings, teachers can celebrate learning by allowing students to share experiences and artifacts from these activities.

Early learners through grade 5 will have access to pre-populated Learning Menus that guide students through required activities in Math, ELA/ELD, and SEL (blue band). Upon completion of the required assignments, students will choose an additional two activities per day from the VAPA, Technology, and PE choices (yellow band).
