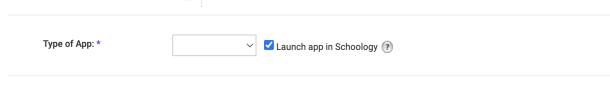
- **Assignment setup**

1. Add external tool assignment
2. Activity name - whatever needed
3. Preconfigured tool - Choose previously created tool
4. Click on Select Content
 - a. Select lesson from Editmentor that is needed to link
5. Click on Save

Schoology Configuration:

1. Go to App Center -> My Developer Apps
2. Click on Add App button

- a. Fill in the required descriptive fields.
- b. Can be installed for - select Course Materials
- c. Scroll until you see the Type of App and select "LTI 1.3 App"

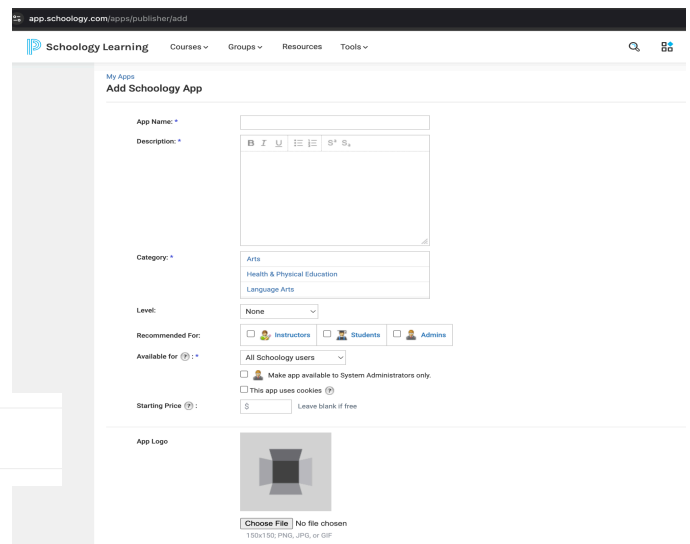

3. Click on Install LTI 1.3 App
4. In the popup click on "I agree", then click on "Continue".
5. In next pop up choose "Add to organization "
