During the meeting:

- At the beginning of the meeting the Master of Ceremony would ask you to introduce your role to the audience.
- Listen carefully to word usage of speakers during the meeting
- Write down any creative use of English (powerful words, quotes etc.,) that enhances a speech, and the names of the persons who used it.
- Write down any awkward use or misuse of the English language, including sentences that are incomplete [DO NOT NOTE THE NAMES]
- Record who used the "Word of the Day" (just keep track of the count 1 + 1 + 1... so on).
- When called at the end of the meeting by the Master of Ceremony, give a report from your notes. When pointing out errors, offer the correct usage. DO NOT MENTION THE NAME OF SPEAKERS, WHEN POINTING OUT INCORRECT USAGES. Your report should take no more than a minute or two.



Sample Wordsmith Script – Beginning of the Meeting

"As the Wordsmith, I shall keep track of the GOOD and NOT SO GOOD usages of English language. I will also keep a note of speakers who used the **Word of the Day** in their speeches.

The Word of the Day today is "compassion". It's meaning is "understanding or pity for somebody who is suffering". An example usage is "Rithika showed great compassion by volunteering at the homeless shelter". I encourage all the speakers to use the Word of the Day. When someone uses the word of the day, the audience shall applaud to encourage them.

At the end of the meeting, when called upon by the Master of Ceremony, I shall present my report.
