Background

The United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs, in collaboration with the D-8 Organization for Economic Cooperation which includes Bangladesh, Egypt, Indonesia, Iran, Malaysia, Nigeria, Pakistan, and Turkey, organized a fully online capacity building workshop on innovative approaches to e-government for SDG (Sustainable Development Goals) implementation in March 2022. The objective of the workshop was to raise awareness of innovative approaches in E-Government policies and implementation strategies and increase participants' capacities on how to use them for the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals.

This Workshop served as a particularly important platform to share diverse country practices, challenges, and innovative cases on the use and implementation of Information and Communication Technologies (ICTs) policies and strategies. Some of the most frequent areas of assistance and required support include (1) capacity development of public officials in digital government in terms of digital skills and talent. Further, support was requested in (2) enhancing collaboration between government agencies, as well as in (3) establishing smart cities. In addition, assistance was deemed necessary in (4) the adoption and sharing of open standards, and (5) the promotion of the production of indigenous ICTs access devices for public servants and the educational sector. Finally, D-8 Members require support in (6) technology transfers by exploring investment opportunities and bi- and multilateral cooperation, and in foreign investment in high-tech and other industrial parks. These areas of assistance are summarised in the Figure below:

Capacity Development of public officials in digital government skills
Enhancing collaboration between government agencies
Promotion of production of indigenous ICT access for public officials and the educational sector
Technology transfers by exploring investment and cooperation opportunities
Adoption and sharing of open standards
Establishment of smart cities

Drawing from the outcome and feedback from participants of March's virtual workshop, UNDESA and D-8 Organization are going to organize another capacity-building workshop entitled "Implementing New Approaches to E-government for SDG Implementation".

Objective

The Workshop of November 2022 is designed to build the capacity of relevant officials, who are responsible for shaping the digital transformation policy, for answering to the ever-growing challenges they face in implementing their respective digital transformation agendas. The Workshop will serve as a continuation of the online Workshop conducted in March, particularly to address the challenges presented during that Workshop. The Workshop is also aimed at enhancing the capacity of public officials in digital government skills, strengthening collaboration between government agencies, and promoting production of indigenous ICT access for public officials and the educational sector.

Target Audience

The target audience of the Workshop is relevant ministries or authorities from the D-8 Member States responsible for the policy and decision-making on e-governance and digital transformation. As such, the D-8 Member States are expected to nominate two participants, preferably one at the senior management level and another from the mid-management level.

Expected Outcomes

Participants are expected to actively contribute to the discussion to create a common understanding of the challenges faced by the Member States in their respective transition toward e-governance and digital public services and identify solutions and responses to those potentially arising challenges. The Workshop aims to provide recommendations that cater to and respond to generic or specific needs from each D-8 Member State to accelerate and strengthen their digital transformation efforts.

Language: The working language of the Workshop will be English, and no interpretation services will be provided.
