Freshman & Sophomore Year

• Freshmen and Sophomores are not allowed to leave campus for lunch.

Junior Year

Second Trimester

Juniors may earn the privilege of driving off-campus or riding as a passenger in a vehicle at the start of the second trimester of their Junior year, provided they meet the following criteria during the first trimester of their Junior year:

- ➤ Not failed more than one course.
- ➤ Not exceeding five days of unexcused absences.

Third Trimester

Juniors may earn or lose the privilege of riding as a passenger in a vehicle or driving off-campus at the start of the third trimester of their Junior year, provided they meet the following criteria during the second trimester of their Junior year:

- > Not failed more than one course.
- ➤ Not exceeding five days of unexcused absences.

Senior Year

Seniors may earn or lose the privilege of riding as a passenger in a vehicle or driving off-campus based on their academic and attendance records from the prior trimester. To maintain this privilege, seniors must:

- ➤ Not more than one failed course during the preceding trimester.
- ➤ Have zero truancies, with unexcused absences not exceeding ten days during the prior trimester.

The administration may revoke open campus privileges for students who violate the school code of conduct, school board policy, local municipal ordinances, or state law.
