Grading: What are the expectations for band/choir students?

As we approach the middle of the school year, it's a good time to review the expectations of band and/or choir students. We want families and students to know what is on their to-do list and help them be successful. The music grade has two parts: attendance and online assignments. Attendance is coming to his/her lab for 20 minutes each week. If a student misses, he/she should contact Mrs. Winkler or Mrs. Stowers to schedule a make up. For grading, an attended lab is 10/10 and a missed lab is 7/10. Online assignments are given roughly every two weeks. These are short 10-15 minute assignments to check for understanding of skills practiced in labs. There are no points taken off for late assignments. Please check Canvas-Grades and/or Infinite Campus to see if you have any missing assignments. If a student misses 3 labs in a row, we will email/call home to notify.
