There are monuments (statues) of Peter the Great in St. Petersburg.

In 1712 Peter moved to St. Petersburg to construct "Paradise".

Peter died because of a bladder infection.

Peter had 2 wives and 14 children, and 1 son named Tsarevich Alexei Petrovich.
