

Printing Report Cards and Progress Reports

Overview


Principals and Grading Coordinators have the ability to print report cards (RCs) and progress reports (PRs). RCs and PRs always print with the same posted grades that appear in transcripts records.

To Print Report Cards or Progress Reports, follow the steps below:

- 1. Make sure you are in School View.
- 2. Click the Student top tab.
 - a. To print report cards for all students in the school, make sure that *All Active Students* appears in the upper-right corner of the student list.

NOTE: If All Active Students is not initially displayed, choose it from the filter menu.

b. To print report cards for a subset of students (e,g, a single grade level), change the selection in the filter menu (e.g. choose "Grade Level = ?," and select a grade level)



- 3. Click on the **Reports** Menu Reports ▼
 - a. For Grades 1-8 students, choose ES Progress Report or ES Report Card**
 - b. For Kindergarten students, choose Kindergarten Report Card
 - c. For High School students, choose HS Progress Report or HS Report Card
- 4. In the resulting popup window:
 - a. Leave "Students to include"at "Current Selection"
 - b. Select the "Letter Language" the language(s) in which the reports should print*
 - c. Select the appropriate grading Term (e.g. Term 1, Term 2....)
 - d. Select a sort order under "Sort students by"
 - e. Leave "Format" as "Adobe Acrobat (PDF)"
 - f. Click the **Run** button, and the **PDF report will appear in a popup window** in a few seconds. Larger schools may take a few minutes to complete.

* "All in English" = English only; "In the Language of Record" = one report in the Report Card Language only; "Both" = two reports for students with a

Report Card Language other than English. Set a student's Report Card Language at Student \rightarrow


For Students with Secondary Enrollments (Home-schooled, Evening Schools, Summer Schools, etc.)

1. Click the Student top tab



NOTE: If All Secondary Students is not initially displayed, choose it from the filter I menu

- 2. Choose the "All Secondary Students" filter:
 - a. To print report cards for Secondary Students in the school, make sure that *All Secondary Students* appears in the upper-right corner of the student list



- 3. Click on the Reports Menu
 - a. For Evening School, choose Evening School Report Card

- b. For Home-Schooled students, choose ES/HS Progress Report or ES/HS Report Card
- c. For Summer School, Grade 1st-8th, choose **ES Summer Progress Report** or **ES Summer Report Card**
- d. For Summer High School students, choose HS Summer Report Card
- 4. In the resulting popup window:
 - a. Leave "Students to include"at "Current Selection"
 - b. Select the "Letter Language" the language(s) in which the reports should print*
 - c. Select the appropriate grading Term (e.g. Term 1, Term 2....)
 - d. Select a sort order under "Sort students by"
 - e. Leave "Format" as "Adobe Acrobat (PDF)"
 - f. Click the **Run** button, and the **PDF report will appear in a popup window** in a few seconds. Larger schools may take a few minutes to complete.

NOTE: Prior to SY2021, Speaking, Listening, and Research grades were reported separately on ES progress reports, report cards, and transcripts. In SY2021, the Research Standards course was eliminated, and Speaking & Listening Standards were combined into a single reported subject.
