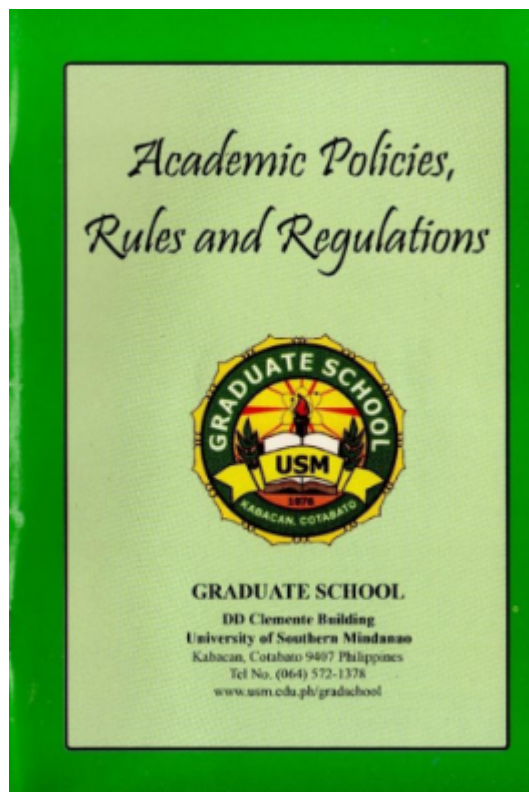

S.1. There is a policy on graduation requirements.

- Policies on program's academic and graduation requirements.

The graduation requirements are described in Section 78 to 82 of the Graduate School Academic Policies, Rules and Regulations.

1. Section 78. Requirements for graduation include the completion of all academic as well as non- academic requirements in accordance with set deadlines.
2. Section 79. If some graduation requirements were completed beyond the set deadlines, the student must register in the succeeding semester to be considered as candidate for graduation as of the end of the last semester of registration.
3. Section 80. All candidates for graduation must have all their deficiencies made up and all their records cleared not later than four (4) weeks before the end of their last semester with the exception of those academic subjects in which the student currently enrolled in.
4. Section 81. A student who fails to pay all required academic and graduation fees cannot be conferred any title or degree.
5. Section 82. Clearance may be obtained by accomplishing designated USMGS Forms. Students who have completed academic or all other requirements including submission of required clearance forms and fees may qualify for graduation. Granting of honourable dismissal and issuance of transcript of record and diploma shall be withheld pending submission of clearance by the student.



Graduation Requirements

Graduation requirements are made known to students during the freshmen orientation program conducted by the University and followed – up by College level orientation. Semestral evaluation on academic standing of students are also enforced by the Admission and Records Office (ARO) or Registrar’s Office. Graduation requirements are clearly defined in the Graduate School Manual for Academic policies, rules and regulations. All students are provided with the said Manual. For a student to graduate and be conferred the MS degree, he / she must:

- a. have filed a formal application as candidate for graduation
- b. have completed / satisfied all academic and other requirements prescribed for graduation
- c. have been cleared of all accounts and responsibilities

No student shall be graduated from the University unless his / her name is approved as a candidate for graduation by the University Academic Council and confirmed by the Board of Regents (BOR).

The above-mentioned academic and graduation requirements are disseminated by the Graduate School and the Program Coordinator. Graduating students are informed of their status even before their last semester registration.
