

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy ("Policy") explains the information collection, use, and sharing practices of Save Image As ("we," "us," and "our").

Unless otherwise stated, this Policy describes and governs the information collection, use, and sharing practices of Save Image As with respect to your use of our services ("Services") that we provide and/or host.

Before you use or submit any information through or in connection with the Services, please carefully review this Privacy Policy. By using any part of the Services, you understand that your information will be collected, used, and disclosed as outlined in this Privacy Policy.

If you do not agree to this Privacy Policy, please do not use our Services.

Our Principles

Save Image As has designed this Policy to be consistent with the following principles:

- Privacy policies should be human readable and easy to find.
- Data collection, storage, and processing should be simplified as much as possible to enhance security, ensure consistency, and make our practices easy for users to understand.
- Data practices should meet the reasonable expectations of users.

Information We Collect

We collect information in multiple ways, including when you provide information directly to us, when we passively collect information from your browser or device, and when the extension processes content locally in order to perform its core functionality.

Information You Provide Directly to Us

We may collect information you provide to us directly, such as when you:

- contact us;
- send support requests;
- provide feedback;
- communicate with us by email.

This information may include your name, email address, and any other information you choose to include in your message.

Information that Is Automatically Collected

Device and Usage Information

We may automatically collect certain information about the computer or browser you use to access the Services. As described further below, we may collect and analyze:

- device and browser information, such as browser type, browser language, operating system, and extension version;
- technical data such as IP address, request timestamps, and error information when our hosted pages or backend services are used;
- information about how users interact with the Services, such as page visits, feature usage, context menu actions, settings changes, save attempts, successful saves, failed saves, and similar operational events.

Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies

Our hosted website pages may use standard web technologies such as cookies, local storage, or server logs to support basic site functionality, analytics, security, and performance monitoring.

You can usually change your browser settings to notify you when a cookie is being set or updated, or to block cookies altogether. Please consult your browser's help settings for more information. Please note that disabling cookies may affect some parts of our hosted pages.

Content Processing Within the Extension

This section describes how the Save Image As browser extension processes content submitted through the extension itself. It applies only to interactions with our own extension and backend, and does not apply to content on third-party websites that you may visit while the extension is installed.

What We Process

When you use the extension, it may process:

- images that you explicitly choose to save from a web page;
- image source URLs and related technical metadata needed to retrieve and convert the selected image;
- limited page context related to the save action;
- locally stored extension settings and preferences.

How We Process It

- When you right-click an image and choose a save format, the extension accesses the selected image on that page.
- The extension retrieves the selected image and processes it locally in the browser.
- Image conversion is performed locally through the extension's own processing flow, including an offscreen document where needed for format conversion.
- The resulting file is saved to your device using the browser download flow.
- If analytics are enabled, the extension may send limited event data to our backend, which acts as a proxy for analytics ingestion.

Storage

- We do not upload or store the actual image content you save for conversion on our servers as part of the normal core save flow.
- The extension may store settings locally in your browser, such as preferred output format, save behavior, toast preferences, installation date, anonymous installation identifier, and related functional settings.
- Our backend may receive and forward analytics events and may log technical metadata associated with requests, such as timestamps, request status, extension version, and anonymous identifiers used for product analytics.
- We do not use the extension to collect the contents of your general browsing activity unrelated to the extension's save flow.

Who Processes It

By using the extension, you understand that:

- selected images are processed locally by the extension in your browser for the purpose of converting and saving them;
- limited analytics and technical request data may be processed by our backend or infrastructure providers;
- hosted pages related to the extension, such as welcome or uninstall pages, may also send analytics events to our backend.

Your Controls

- You can stop using the extension at any time.
- You can uninstall the extension at any time.
- You can clear locally stored extension data through your browser's extension storage controls or by removing the extension.
- You can choose not to contact us or submit feedback.

How We Use Your Information

We may use the information we collect from and about you to:

- provide the core functionality of the extension;
- let you save web images in the format you choose, including PNG, JPG, WebP, or PDF;
- remember your settings and preferences;
- operate, maintain, and improve the Services;
- understand feature usage and product performance;
- diagnose bugs, failures, and technical issues;
- protect against abuse, fraud, and security risks;
- communicate with you if you contact us;
- comply with legal obligations.

When We Disclose Your Information

We may disclose your information in the following circumstances:

Service Providers

We may share information with vendors, hosting providers, infrastructure providers, analytics providers, and other service providers that help us operate the Services.

Analytics and Operational Processing

If analytics are enabled, event data may be sent from the extension or hosted pages to our backend and then forwarded to our analytics ingestion provider. This event data is used for product analytics, operational monitoring, and service improvement.

Legal Compliance and Protection

We may disclose information if required to do so by law or if we believe in good faith that such disclosure is reasonably necessary to:

- comply with legal obligations or legal process;
- protect our rights or property;
- investigate fraud, abuse, or security issues;
- protect the safety of users or others.

Business Transfers

If we are involved in a merger, acquisition, asset sale, financing, reorganization, bankruptcy, or similar transaction, information may be transferred as part of that transaction.

Affiliated Companies

We may disclose information with current or future affiliated companies, subject to this Privacy Policy.

Consent

We may disclose your information to third parties when you give us consent to do so.

Aggregate or De-identified Information

We may disclose de-identified, aggregated, or anonymized information for lawful business purposes, including analytics, reporting, and product improvement.

Legal Basis for Processing Personal Data

To the extent applicable law requires us to identify a legal basis for processing personal data, our bases may include:

To Honor Our Contractual Commitments to You

Much of our processing of information is to provide the Services you request, including the extension's image-saving and conversion functionality.

Legitimate Interests

In many cases, we process information because it furthers our legitimate interests in ways that are not overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of affected individuals. These legitimate interests include:

- operating and improving the Services;
- maintaining product quality and reliability;
- customer support;
- analytics and performance measurement;
- protecting the Services from misuse;
- managing legal and operational issues.

Legal Compliance

We may process and disclose information where necessary to comply with applicable legal obligations.

Consent

Where required by law, and in certain other situations, we process information on the basis of consent.

Online Analytics

We may use analytics services or infrastructure to collect and analyze limited information about use of the Services, including extension events and hosted page usage. This may include information such as extension version, browser type, event timestamps, anonymous installation identifiers, normalized page URLs related to save actions, selected output format, and technical request metadata.

These analytics help us understand usage trends, diagnose issues, and improve the extension. We do not use analytics to store the image content that users save through the extension's normal local conversion flow.

Your Choices and Data Subject Rights

You may have various rights with respect to the collection and use of your information, depending on your jurisdiction. These may include the right to:

- request access to your personal information;
- request correction of inaccurate information;
- request deletion of information;
- object to or restrict certain processing;
- withdraw consent where processing is based on consent.

International Transfers

As described above, we may share information with service providers or partners located in countries other than your country of residence. By using the Services, you understand that your information may be transferred to and processed in jurisdictions that may not provide the same level of legal protection as your home jurisdiction. Where required, we take reasonable steps to ensure appropriate safeguards are in place.

Security Measures

We have implemented technical, administrative, and organizational measures designed to protect against loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, or alteration of your information. However, no method of Internet transmission or electronic storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

Children

The Services are not directed to children, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children under the age required by applicable law. If we become aware that we have collected personal information from a child in violation of applicable law, we will take reasonable steps to delete it.

Data Retention

We retain information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, including to provide the Services, comply with legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce agreements.

Locally stored extension settings remain in your browser until they are deleted, reset, or removed by uninstalling the extension. Server-side logs and analytics records may be retained for a limited period appropriate for operational, analytics, legal, and security purposes.

Third-Party Links and Services

The Services may contain links to third-party websites or rely on third-party website content in order for the extension to function on those pages. Save Image As is not responsible for the privacy practices of third-party websites or services. The collection, use, and disclosure of your information by such third parties is governed by their own privacy policies, not this Privacy Policy.

We encourage you to read the privacy policies of every website and service you use.

Changes to this Privacy Policy

We may continue to evaluate this Privacy Policy as we update and expand the Services, and we may make changes accordingly. We will post any updates here and revise the "Last Updated" date above. We encourage you to review this page periodically to stay informed about our privacy practices.

If we make material changes, we will provide notice as required by applicable law.
