• 10:30 AM - Start out on tour

- North on Glover Road, going straight through at light (Do not take Hwy 10 By Pass), go across railway tracks which would be the site of a station for Trinity students and staff and Fort Langley traffic, continue North on Glover past entrance to Trinity Western University go around traffic circle and back to Hwy 10 By Pass, turning left heading East towards Hwy 1.
- o Get onto Hwy 1 East bound, get off Hwy 1 at 264th, go over overpass to north side of Hwy 1 and drive through Gloucester on 56th an 800 acre Ind. Park that contains 250 businesses and 35,000 employees with NO public transportation available. This is a site for a Station feeding Gloucester Ind. Park and Van. Game Farm also fed by bus service from Aldergrove home to 14,000 residents estimated to be 25,000 residents in 10 years.
- Turn around and go back onto 264th South over overpass back onto Hwy 1 East bound. Point out that 5 minutes south is the community of Aldergrove with very limited public transportation. Just 2 minutes away on 264th is the very popular Vancouver Game Farm with NO public transit.
