Art Display Agreement 2024

I, the undersigned, agree with the following statements:

- The artwork is original and created solely by the artist, not using AI.
- The artwork is not under contractual agreements that would interfere with or prevent displaying in a public building.
- The artwork is suitable for display in a public building frequented by persons of all ages. The artwork is not confrontational or controversial. It does not depict nudity, sexual acts, profanity, or obscenity.
- The Library reserves the right to select artwork that it deems appropriate for the space and chosen theme. It will select work that presents an interesting variety of subjects and media. The artwork will be displayed throughout the Library according to staff discretion.
- Artwork falls within the size limits:
 - 2-D: Works does not exceed 28" x 28". The artwork is mounted or framed and ready to hang. The wire is mounted 1/3 of distance from top of frame.
 - 3-D: Works fall within the following parameters: 10" W x 10" H.
- The artist acknowledges display space is not secure, and the Library provides no insurance for the artwork submitted. The artist holds harmless the Library and staff of any liability of damage, theft, liability or loss.
- The artist may provide publicity business cards or biographical information.
- The artist will provide titles and name of the medium used for each piece submitted.
- The artist agrees to allow the Library to photograph and use images of the artwork for publicity and promotion.

Short Descriptions of Themes

Celebrations: Works that explore the theme of "Celebrations", from traditional moments to personal triumphs. It is open to your artistic interpretation and expression.

Turning the Page: Works that explore the idea of new beginnings or change; or the more concrete themes of books, chapters or pages. It is open to your artistic interpretation and expression.

Reflections: Works that interpret the idea of "Reflection", such as images you see reflected on surfaces, careful thoughts on a topic, or the story of Narcissus in Greek mythology. The theme is open to your artistic interpretation and expression.

Adventures Begin at the Library: Works that expound upon the theme of "Adventures Begin at the Library", such as books, reading, a genre (ex. mystery, fantasy, fairy tales/folklore), travel, and technology. The theme is open to your artistic interpretation and expression.

Nature: Works that explore the theme of "Nature", focusing on items found in the natural world. The theme is open to your artistic interpretation and expression.
