5. Principal's Report -Bianca Sines

- Trunk or Treat unable to attend but had coverage. Turnout was huge and I heard nothing but good things.
- Data meetings are complete since the last meeting. Erin's team puts together data we have collected and go through it grade by grade and pull support based on data. Supports are now in place.
- Math Pilot supports intervention in place (EPIC) through Oakland County.
 One teacher liaison (Hauswirth) is going through the program, focus is 4-6 grades. Oakland Schools will go through our data and then we'll trickle down.
- Conferences are next week, check with your child's teacher on scheduling. Wednesday and Thursday are half days.
- PBIS meeting on the 15th, meeting with Oakland Schools on the 18th.
 Using the matrices and creating expectations posters using photos of students to and then will be hung around the building.
- Kindergarten playgrounds will be completed tomorrow as long as the sign-offs are completed when Mrs. Sines in the morning. Temporary fence is up and permanent will be in place soon. This playground is designated for TK and K ONLY.
- Gym completion targeted for November 22nd. We can look into Assemblies after December 1st.
- A parent/colleague shared some excerpts from <u>The Anxious Generation</u> was super helpful and will share for others.
- Executive Functioning has been the focus of two recent PD sessions led by Sara Provost. Sharing tips on how to work with students.
- External Lockdowns if there is an issue outside of the school
- If a medical/student crisis is in place, we do ask teachers to stay in their classrooms to be able to preserve the dignity of those impacted.
