The abstract should clearly present the introduction, objectives, methods, results, and conclusions. It must be written in both English and Indonesian, each in a single paragraph, not exceeding 250 words, and typed in Times New Roman, 11 pt, single-spaced.

Keywords: (*Times New Roman, 11 pt, Italic*) Maximum of five words, excluding words in the title, arranged in alphabetical order.

Introduction (*Times New Roman, 11 pt, Bold*)

(Times New Roman, 11 pt, single-spaced). The introduction should include background information and research objectives. The manuscript should be typed using Microsoft Word (.docx) on A4-sized paper with 3.0 cm margins.

Materials and Methods (*Times New Roman, 11 pt, Bold*)

(Times New Roman, 11 pt, single-spaced). This section should describe the research location, data collection methods, types of data obtained, and data analysis techniques.

Results and Discussion (*Times New Roman, 11 pt, Bold*)

(Times New Roman, 11 pt, single-spaced). This section presents the research findings and analysis comprehensively. The discussion should address the research objectives outlined in the Introduction.

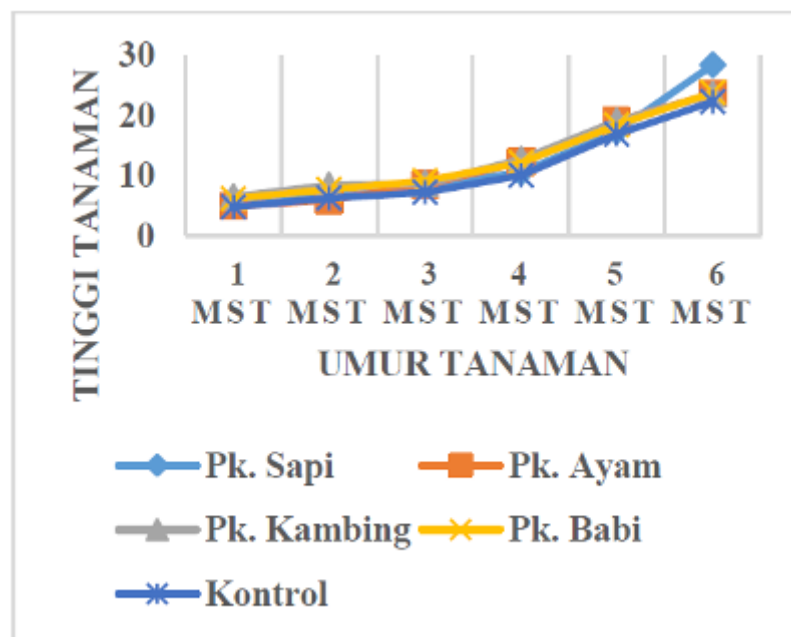


Figure 1. Tinggi Tanam (Times New Roman, 11 pt, single-spaced)

(Times New Roman, 10 pt, single-spaced). References should follow the Harvard citation style. List references alphabetically by the author's last name. Each reference should be formatted as follows:
