

Welcome back Jaguars!

We are looking forward to a fabulous school year! As we begin the new school year, we want to ensure that all parents are aware of our JJB grading policies that connect to the CCSD Grading Reform expectations. Teachers shared this information during their Open House presentations on August 7, 2026, and will review it during Parent-Teacher Conferences during the week of October 19, 2026.

In order to ensure some consistency across JJB, these are a few expectations for 1st through 5th grade, related to CCSD Grade Reform guidelines.

- Formative Assessments will account for 10% of the final grade.
- Students do not have the opportunity to retake formative assessments, as these assessments provide valuable information to inform instruction and determine if students are prepared for a summative assessment.
- Summative assessments will account for 90% of the final grade.
- Grades will follow the CCSD elementary school grading scale: [Elementary Grading Scale](#)
- Students have the opportunity to retake summative assessments after reteaching of the material by requesting the retake through a request form similar to this example: [JJB Summative Retake Agreement Form](#) . All summatives must be retaken no later than two weeks prior to the end of the term. Teachers will teach this process to students and communicate expectations to families with their form.
- Late assignments can be submitted up to five days after the due date.

- Homework expectations are in accordance with [Policy 6143](#) and [Regulation 6143](#). Homework is considered practice or an extension of learning. For this reason, the completion of homework impacts Learner Behavior grades, it does not count toward the final content area grade.
- Learner behavior grades (classroom citizenship and other nonacademic measures) are determined using the rubric.

- Bi-weekly reminders for parents to review Infinite Campus for missing assignments and updated grades will be sent through Parentlink.

If you require a printed copy of the progress report and/or report card, please reach out to your child's teacher, otherwise we have an understanding that parents are reviewing student progress through Infinite Campus. We will send a parentlink friendly reminder to check grades every two weeks.
